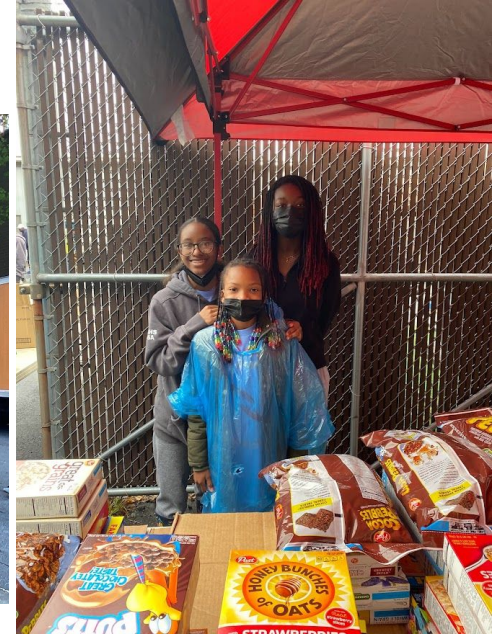
HBCU Campus Tour

Community Partner Volunteerism

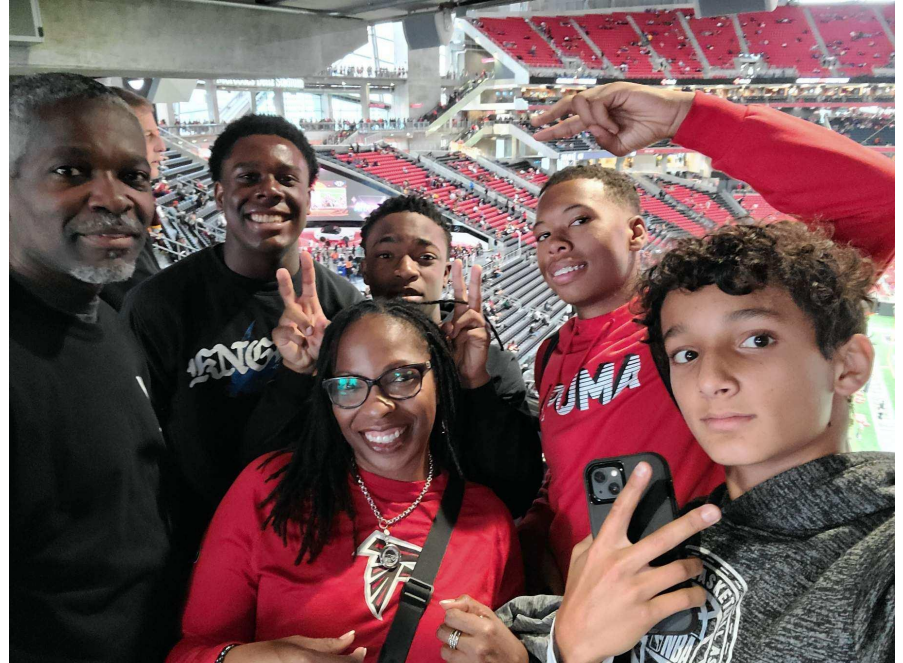
